Reporting to the Community

RATIONALE:

In accordance with the Education Act and Handbook for Boards of Trustees of New Zealand Catholic Integrated schools, Aquinas College will review and provide feedback on student achievement, and all key goals, including Government priority groups.

GUIDELINES:

Aquinas College will:

- Report to students and parents in a clear and concise manner.
- Report to the school's community on the achievement of students as a whole and of groups including the achievement of Government priority groups, such as Maori & Pasifika students, (including the achievement of students in relation to the National Standards at Years 7 & 8.)
- Maintain an on-going programme of self-review, with reference to reporting.
- Ensure all legal obligations are met.

PROCEDURES:

1. Aquinas College will inform the Community of the general direction of National/College Education, and consult the Community on matters of interest/development.
2. Formal reports to parents will provide information on student achievement.
3. The Board will ensure that the Charter and Policies are available.
4. Reports will reflect the requirements of the Integration Agreement, MOE Guidelines and the Handbook for Boards of Trustees of New Zealand Catholic Integrated schools.
